

CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

Within the framework of the programs offered by *Base de Plein Air Mont-Tremblant*, our staff members wish to inform participants of 10 rules of conduct that must be respected. We invite parents and campers alike to read attentively before signing.

1. Respect others (campers, activity leaders, all personnel at the *Base de Plein Air*).
2. Smoking, along with drug and alcohol use, is strictly prohibited to all campers.
3. Respect the areas reserved for girls or boys.
4. During the optional "waterfalls activity, all campers must remain in the water park area. Do not encourage visits from friends on this day and remember that your child is under camp supervision.
5. Wear appropriate clothing (jeans with holes are not tolerated for safety reasons).
6. Possession of any type of knife or jackknife is strictly prohibited.
7. No abuse, whether physical or verbal, will be tolerated. This includes negative attitudes.
8. Respect camp facilities, equipment and safety rules.
9. Vandalism and graffiti will not be tolerated.
10. Do not bring any food, candy, chewing gum, soda or anything else subject to dispute or possible theft.

CONTRACT

I, the undersigned, agree to follow these rules set out by the staff members (counsellors, activity leaders, director of the *Base de Plein Air*).

I accept and will comply with the proposed schedule, be present at designated meeting times and not venture off on my own, causing people to worry and thus ruining the atmosphere.

I will respect the rules concerning meal times, activities and bedtimes. Free time will be spent outdoors. not in my room. I will remain in the room assigned to me upon arrival at *La Base*.

Under no circumstances will I allowed to go to the lakeshore or in the lake without the supervision of a staff member.

If I do not respect the camper code of conduct during my stay, staff administration at the *Base* reserves the right to send me home at my parents' expense.

I have read and agree to abide by the clauses set out in this contract.
